1. Filing of Skeletons & bundles

<u>Unless the Court has ordered otherwise</u>, skeletons and bundles are to be lodged in the Supreme Court Registry at least 3 clear working days before the hearing.

The Registry will no longer be sending out email reminders to practitioners.

2. Renaming of D & M Jurisdiction

Practitioners are advised that due to the introduction of the Civil Partnership Act 2014, the Divorce & Matrimonial Jurisdiction will now be referred to as the Divorce, Dissolution & Matrimonial Jurisdiction. Action numbers will be set as 'DDM'.

3. Practitioner References

In order to assist the Registry, practitioners are requested to include, in documents filed in Court, the reference or name of the individual practitioner having the day to day conduct of a matter and not just the name/signature of the firm. This will enable the Registry staff to liaise with the practitioner when required.
